Dr. Richard C. Miller elected to PERS Board of Trustees



Dr. Richard C. Miller, retired physician and professor of pediatrics at University of Mississippi Medical Center, has been elected as a retiree representative on the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi (PERS) Board of Trustees.

At its April 27 meeting, the Board certified results of the runoff election between Miller, of Jackson, and Randy D. McCoy, of Tupelo.

Miller previously served on the Board from 1993 to 2008 as a representative of the state's institutions of higher learning. His new term began May 1 and fills a position left vacant at the term completion of Lester Herrington, who served 16 years on the Board.

The 10-member PERS Board includes the state treasurer, a gubernatorial appointee who is a member of PERS, two retirees, two state employees and one representative each of public schools and community colleges, institutions of higher learning, counties and municipalities. With the exception of the state treasurer and the gubernatorial appointee, board members are elected to staggered six-year terms.
