Robertson elected to National Association of State Retirement Administrators post



Pat Robertson, executive director of the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi (PERS), has been named president-elect of the Executive Board by members of the National Association of State Retirement Administrators (NASRA).

NASRA is a non-profit association whose members are the directors of the nation's state, territorial, and largest statewide public retirement systems. NASRA members oversee retirement systems that hold more than \$2 trillion in assets, and provide pension and other benefits to more than two-thirds of all state and local government employees. Robertson assumes the position after serving as first vice president for the organization.

A graduate of Mississippi State University with a bachelor's in accounting, Robertson has worked at PERS since 1980 and has served as the agency's executive director since 2005. Along with NASRA, she is a member of the Governmental Accounting Standards Advisory Council, Bank of New York Client Advisory Board, Mississippi State University College of Business Executive Advisory Board, National Council on Teacher Retirement Legislative Committee, Advisory Board of the Mississippi Certified Public Manager Program, and a graduate of the State Executive Development Institute of the John C. Stennis Institute of Government at Mississippi State University. Robertson is a Certified Public Accountant, Certified Government Financial Manager, Certified Public Manager, Certified Retirement Counselor, and Certified Retirement Administrator. She also has been involved with the Government Finance Officers' Association of the United States and Canada, serving on the Executive Board from 2003 to 2006 and as a representative to the Public Pension Coordinating Council from 2001 to 2003.
